Mini Squad will be conducted in two terms throughout the season Spring (Term 4 2011) & Summer Blocks (Term 1 2012) plus two (2) intensive 1 week blocks during the Christmas holidays.

CLASSES

IMPORTANT: A parent or responsible adult **MUST** be present during **MINI SQUAD** classes.

Education Department regulations require that each swimmer must shower and visit the toilet before entering the pool. Classes will always proceed except in the event of a thunderstorm. If in doubt, please check with the coaching staff at the pool.

PARENTS PLEASE NOTE

Coaching staff at Jamboree Heights Swimming Club love what they do and are happy to discuss with parents their child's progress outside of class time. For your child to gain maximum benefit from their expertise it is requested that you do not distract your child by talking to or approaching them during the lesson unless requested to by the coaching staff.

A communication book for messages can be found at the end of the pool under the clock if you don't get the appropriate opportunity to speak with your child's coach or if you need to leave a message for the Mini Squad Manager who is also a coach.

The coaching staff cannot accept responsibility for the safety of children before or after their lesson. **Parents MUST remain at the pool for the duration of their child's lesson.** In the case of an emergency a parent needs to be available for immediate consultation.

Parents are responsible for supervising any other children they have brought with them. Please keep other children away from the swimming pool/teaching area. Insurance cover only applies to the children who are enrolled in the Mini Squad Program.

Please remember we are a community-based organisation and rely entirely on parent volunteers to keep the pool and it's surrounds clean and tidy, so we do ask that you leave the pool area tidy.
